



Membership of the Reuse Network Eligibility

Full membership is available to any **Voluntary Sector** or **Charitable Organisation**, based and operating within the UK, which is involved in at least one of the following four activities:

- the re-use and sale/donation of furniture for the benefit of people on low income or by assisting those marginalised in the job market through the provision of work experience, employment and/or training
- The re-use and sale/donation of electrical appliances for the benefit of people on low income by assisting those marginalised in the job market by the provision of work experience, employment and/or training
- The collection or distribution of furniture or appliances for the benefit of people on low income or by assisting those marginalised in the job market by the provision of work experience, employment and/or training
- The repair or reprocessing of furniture or appliances for the benefit of people on low incomes or by assisting those marginalised in the job market by the provision of work experience, employment and/or training

To ensure that organisations qualify for full membership all new members will be requested to send a copy of their Governing documents to the Reuse Network. They will also need to evidence that they are fulfilling the above criteria of membership annually upon renewal.

All Full Members will also be expected to sign/accept a declaration that they agree to abide by the rules and the Memorandum and Articles of Association as agreed at the Annual General Meeting of 13th March 2014 and in line with Terms & Conditions on back page of Membership Form to be completed each year.

Membership fees will be reviewed annually by the Board with a sliding scale at Core level based upon the financial turnover of the project. Full members will be entitled to full voting rights and may be nominated to voting positions on the Board of Directors. Full membership operates on a system of one member one vote. No member may have more than one vote at any Reuse Network meeting with the exception of the Chair who may, in the result of a tie, have a second casting vote.

Full rules governing the Reuse Network as agreed at the Annual General Meeting of 13th March 2014 are available upon request.
